

**Cheltenham Cougars v Warwick - 4th October, 2008.**

This is to confirm the finding of the Disciplinary Tribunal regarding the charge of the Cheltenham Lacrosse Club bringing the game into disrepute in the above mentioned match.

The Tribunal found that Cheltenham were guilty.

In deciding on a penalty, the Tribunal took into account the fact that the problems during the game were as a result of the actions of three of the Cheltenham players, whilst other Cheltenham players acted in a restraining manner and behaved responsibly.

The Tribunal has imposed a suspended two league points deduction. The penalty is to take effect from the date of this letter until the 31st January 2009. This finding will be posted on the SEMLA website.

At the hearing, Cheltenham said that they would be taking disciplinary action against the players concerned. Confirmation of this action to the Disciplinary Tribunal would be appreciated.
