READING WILDCATS VERSUS SPENCER 21ST OCTOBER 2006

This is to confirm the findings of the SEMLA disciplinary committee in which you took part on the 8th November 2006

The committee finds you guilty of bringing the game into disrepute by physically and verbally abusing the referee, Trevor Rogers, and by refusing to give your name when asked to do so by Trevor Rogers.

The need for referees is paramount, especially now when the game is rapidly expanding, and your actions deter people from refereeing. The committee is determined to protect referees at all times. Consequently, you are banned for eight consecutive league and flags matches. Since your club has already imposed its own ban starting from 4th November, that will serve as the first week, so effectively the ban will be for the next seven consecutive league and flag matches from the date of this letter.

In imposing this penalty the committee has taken into account your letter of apology to Trevor Rogers and the responsible attitude of Spencer Lacrosse Club to this affair.
